PUBLIC NOTICE

For all property owners/residents abutting, having access to, or interest in the property commonly referring to as Harp Alley "school street" (map attached), please accept this invitation to attend the upcoming Mayor and Council workshop at 7PM on February 7, at the Myersville Town Hall. This meeting will provide opportunity to all interested parties to hear discussion of the Mayor and Council and provide public comment on this matter.

The Mayor and Council have interest in this property for public access, and in follow up to recent deed research, field survey, and site analysis, held discussion at their January regular meeting to consider proceeding forward with one the following three (3) options:

- Leaving the "alley" exist as it does in its current state of condition, use and ownership and deferring to private parties on access, use and maintenance
- Formally accepting the "alley" into the Town street system and properly improving and maintaining it for use by the public.
- Determining the "alley" to be surplus property and conveying it to private abutting owners through formal land transfer process

At the January regular meeting, it was expressed by a majority of Council members to proceed with option two (2). However, the Mayor and Council have deferred taking formal action to that effect to provide for public input from the other parties as noted, which time is being provided to do so at the February workshop. If you cannot attend this meeting in person, you are welcome to convey your comments via or letter, which will be included in the record for consideration.

I am writing to you on behalf of the Parks and Recreation Committee to propose a new location for the trolley art piece that is currently inside the town hall.

The trolley art piece was created by Myersville resident Carrie Bauer, the winner of a public contest organized by the Parks & Rec department last year. One of the benefits of winning the contest was that the art piece would be showcased in one of the parks in Myersville. Therefore, we are asking for your approval and support to move the trolley art piece from the town hall to a park.

We have identified a suitable spot for the art in Memorial Park, on the pedestal that is the right size and matches the theme of the trolley station. We think that this location would enhance the aesthetic and cultural value of the park.

We understand that moving and installing the trolley art may require some logistical and financial arrangements, and we are willing to work with you and other stakeholders to make this happen. We would also appreciate your input on any other considerations or challenges that we may need to address.
